REPORT

SUMMER PASSENGER TRAFFIC RESULTS

As we reflect on the summer travel season, we note that American Airlines followed typical seasonal patterns, resulting in a 10% decrease in available seats for September. This aligns with year-over-year seat availability trends. Despite this, our load factors for the month of September remained exceptionally strong, finishing at 82%. Year-to-date, our load factor stands at 82.6%, demonstrating consistent performance in line with our annual projections. This indicates continued demand for air service at Lynchburg Regional Airport, reflecting a solid foundation for future growth.

TAKEOFF CONFERENCE

In October, members of our staff, along with our Air Service Development Consultant, attended the Takeoff Conference in Green Bay, Wisconsin. This annual event provides an invaluable opportunity to connect with airline representatives and promote potential new routes for our airport. We held productive meetings with four major airlines, showcasing the unique advantages of Lynchburg Regional Airport and the surrounding region. These discussions were incredibly positive, and we are optimistic about potential future routes that could expand connectivity for our travelers.

RUNWAY 4/22 REHABILITATION PROJECT UPDATE

A major project for the coming year is the rehabilitation of our Primary Commercial Service Runway 4/22, which is scheduled to begin in June 2025. This critical infrastructure project was bid over the summer, and we are excited to announce that 95% of the funding will be covered by the FAA Reauthorization Act of 2024, an increase from the typical 90% funding on most airport projects. We are currently finalizing contracts with Lagan US, Inc., who will serve as the contractor for this essential work. The project will enhance runway safety and extend the operational life of our primary runway, reinforcing LYH's position as a key regional airport.

RESTROOM PROJECT COMPLETE

We are pleased to report the successful completion of the Restroom Modernization Project, which wrapped up in October following an extensive 18-month planning and construction phase. The project included the renovation and expansion of our six existing restrooms, as well as the addition of two family restrooms and two nursing mothers rooms. This upgrade significantly enhances the comfort and convenience of our passengers, ensuring a modern and welcoming experience for all travelers.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Lynchburg Regional Airport has actively embraced opportunities to connect with and support our vibrant community. This fiscal year, we have proudly partnered with several local non-profits and charitable organizations, including the Academy Center for the Arts, Girls on the Run, the Lynchburg Symphony Orchestra and Youth Orchestra, the Virginia 10-Miler, CASA and the Superhero Run, The Old City Cemetery Candlelight Tours, United Way, and Wolfbane Productions. These partnerships reflect our commitment to enriching the cultural and philanthropic landscape of Lynchburg. Looking ahead, we are excited to engage with the community at the upcoming Lynchburg Christmas Parade and our Santa at the Airport events in December. We look forward to creating memorable experiences and further strengthening our connection with the people we serve.

(1) <u>CALL TO ORDER</u>:

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Mr. Massie Ware. It was noted that Frank Rogers and Janice Crawford were not in attendance.

(2) APPROVAL OF AUGUST 26, 2024 CONSENT AGENDA

Mr. Massie Ware confirmed that everyone had received the items from the Consent Agenda; the June 03, 2024 Commission Meeting Minutes and asked if there were any questions, comments or changes regarding the consent agenda items. There were no comments.

(3) REPORT OF THE AIRPORT DIRECTOR

A. American Airlines Upcoming Flight Schedules

- (1) AA's fall schedules reflect notable increases...
 - (a) Sept. and Oct. schedules increased to seven daily, most days 9,350 and 9,900
 - (b) scheduled seats (respectively). Goal 12,000 (mixed aircraft)
- (2) Winter has scheduled six daily, most days (normal vs. last winter)
- (3) Jan. through Apr. AA has loaded six daily, most days

B. Parking Revenues

- (1) FY 2024 parking revenue ended at 86% of FY2019 high water mark
- (2) We are seeing considerable increases at the start of FY 2025 (July 1)
- (3) This increase is attributed to two items
 - (a) Increase in flights frequency correlating into more passengers using the facility
 - (b) Planned nominal parking rate increases to regional levels
- (4) Although early to forecast, this rate of monthly increases on average will exceed our FY 2019 high water mark of \$885,709

C. Gross Rental Car Revenues

- (1) October 2023 = \$528,560 -previous high
- (2) May 2024 = \$592,268
- (3) July 2024 = \$569,887
- (4) The last three months exceeded our highest month on record
- (5) This increase is contributed to Hertz returning to the airport
- (6) Higher demand and higher rental car rates

D. Recent Airport Involvement in the Community

- (1) "The Sky is Not the Limit" at Riverviews Artspace
- (2) Aim High at Amazement Square
- (3) Aviation Night at Hillcats Stadium

(4) REPORTS OF AIRPORT BUSINESSES

Dan Deter asked about solar panels on the airfield. Andrew said we've found an area for solar panels, possibly 20-30 acres. We have not yet identified a company to work with for solar. It's on the radar but hasn't been pushed through as of yet. Massie asked about restroom renovations, Andrew replied that all 6 restrooms are complete and we are upgrading the electricity in the terminal. Dan Deter asked if there has been a change in security, due to a person or "TSA" offering to send a tool back to him through mail for \$30.00. Andrew replied that no we do not have a shipping service.

A special announcement from Andrew LaGala that he is joining an airport in North Carolina as airport director by October 1st. Cedric Simon is now named Interim Airport Director.


