



Runway 04/22 Construction Project FAQ's

- **What is this project all about?**
 - Runway 4-22 is the primary runway at Lynchburg Regional Airport (LYH) for all air carrier operations. The runway is 7,100 feet X 150 feet with a precision approach to Runway 4. In an effort to extend the useful life of the runway, this project will rehabilitate the full length of the pavement as well as install a new upgraded lighting system to include a LED High Intensity Runway Lighting and a Medium Approach Lighting System for Runway 22. The pavement and lighting improvements will increase safety for aircraft operators as well as provide for continued capacity at LYH.

- **When will this project be implemented at LYH?**
 - Construction will begin on June 1st, 2025 and continue until August 29th, 2025. Then it will continue again from Oct. 1st-31st, 2025.

- **What time will construction take place on Runway 4-22?**
 - Construction will take place from 12AM-6AM Mon.-Fri. and on Saturday from 12PM to Sunday 12PM.

- **Will flight times be affected due to construction?**
 - Yes, due to construction, flights will take place during weekdays after 6AM, and on weekends before 12PM on Saturday, and after 12PM on Sunday.
