NOTICE OF PFC CONCURRENT IMPOSE AND USE APPLICATION

LYNCHBURG REGIONAL AIRPORT

The City of Lynchburg as Owner and Operator of the Lynchburg Regional Airport, has determined the need to submit an application to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to impose and use a Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) for projects at the Lynchburg Regional Airport. The City is submitting the PFC application under the streamlined Notice of Intent (NOI) process contained in 49 U.S.C. 40117(1). PFC amounts and schedule are as follows:

1. Requested PFC charge level will be maintained at \$4.50 per enplanement
2. Proposed PFC effective date: June 1, 2027
3. Estimated PFC expiration date: February 1, 2039
4. Total Projected Collections: \$3,565,730.00

The projects requested in the PFC application include:

1. Midfield GA Apron & Vehicle Service Road (Construction) to enhance capacity- Reimbursement, Impose and Use, \$1,258,377
2. South GA Ramp Extension (Construction) to enhance capacity- Reimbursement, Impose and Use, \$2,225,353
3. PFC Application Development and Administration, (Preserve Capacity) Impose and Use, \$42,000
4. PFC Administration and Audit Fee, (Preserve Capacity) Impose and Use, \$40,000
